**STUDENT DISCIPLINE**

**Policy Number: A.05.06**

**SCOPE**

All Students.

**PURPOSE**

To outline student discipline policy and process.

**POLICY/PROCEDURE**

Any breach of discipline in the classroom should be reported to the Vice President of Student Affairs and the dean of the school as soon as possible.

Any breach of discipline outside the classroom but on the campus or at a University function should be reported to the Vice President for Student Affairs.

Fair hearing procedures for both academic and non-academic discipline problems have been established by the University. Students accused of behavior contrary to the policies and rules of the University may elect to have a hearing based on these established procedures. Copies of “The Code of Student Conduct” may be obtained from the Vice President for Student Affairs.

A faculty member has the right to require that students observe reasonable norms of conduct and good manners in class.

Smoking, eating and drinking by students or faculty are not permitted in classrooms and laboratories.
