

Step 1: Complete Your UST Application

Your FREE application can be submitted online through www.stthom.edu/apply, Apply Texas, or the Common App.

Submit Your Transcripts

Transcripts are required for admission processing. Make sure to include all institutions, including dual credit. You can have your transcripts emailed to admissions@stthom.edu or mailed to our office. You may submit an unofficial transcript to render an admission decision, but your final official transcript will be required for enrollment.

Submit Your Personal Statement

Submit a personal statement (1-2 pages) answering one or all of the below questions:

1. Explain why you want to attend the University of St. Thomas-Houston (UST)?
2. What do you want to study at UST and why?
3. How do you plan to be a successful student at UST?

Submit Your Test Scores or Request Test-Optional Review

If you wish to submit this information to us, our SAT code **6880** and our ACT code **4238**. If you are requesting Test-Optional Review, you are not required to submit test scores to complete the admissions application. **If you select to be test-optional:**

1. You may have to provide an additional essay explaining why test scores are not reflective of your academic ability.
2. An interview in-person or over the phone with an admissions counselor may be requested before an admissions decision can be rendered.

Step 2: Start Your Financial Aid Planning

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.studentaid.gov. The Office of Financial Aid will review FAFSA results after students are admitted & an official award package will be sent in the mail. UST's FAFSA code is **003654**.
